✓ PLAN AHEAD & SUBMIT EARLY.

Create your profile in our Survey Monkey Apply site and read all of the application instructions before you get started. Use this list to help you prepare. This way, you can submit your application on time with no surprises.

✓ TELL US ABOUT YOURSELF.

Answer questions about yourself and your school experience including GPA, graduation date, major, intended degree, college, community service and school activities, and awards you've received.

✓ GATHER SUPPORTING MATERIALS.

You will need to gather the following materials for your application. Check them off as you go to keep organized.

If you're a graduating high school senior:

- High School Transcript (an unofficial copy is okay)
- College Acceptance Letter (your acceptance email from the college is okay, too)
- Resume (you should include any work experience, volunteer history, and achievements you're proud of)

If you're in college:

- College Transcript (it should show your education-focused degree, an unofficial copy is okay)
- Resume (you should include work experience, volunteer history, and achievements you're proud of)

✓ PREP ESSAY ANSWERS.

The scholarship application has two essay questions:

1. up to 150 words on why MSGCU should select you to receive this scholarship.
 2. 500-1,000 words on the most important lesson you plan to teach your students both in and out of the classroom.
- Pro tip: compose your essays in a Word document (or equivalent) and then copy and paste it into your application.
